Charleston County Hosts Public Meeting on Glenn McConnell Parkway Widening Project

Discussions regarding road-widening project to be held at West Ashley High School on December 3

[Charleston County Government](http://roads.charlestoncounty.org) will host a public meeting to introduce and discuss the Glenn McConnell Parkway Widening project. The meeting is Monday, December 3, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at West Ashley High School (Cafeteria), 4060 West Wildcat Blvd, Charleston, SC 29414. Attendees will use the student/event parking area and follow the signs to the cafeteria.

The meeting will be an open house format and attendees will have the opportunity to learn about the project and meet one-on-one with Charleston County and project team representatives. Citizens will be able to leave comments during the meeting or utilize the on-line form.

The purpose of the project is to relieve traffic congestion by increasing roadway capacity within the existing right-of-way limits of Glenn McConnell Parkway between Bees Ferry Road and Magwood Drive. The goal is to widen Glenn McConnell Parkway from two to three lanes in each direction, and provide a new multi-use pathway within the project limits that will allow safe pedestrian access across the CSX railway.
